



RESERVATION POLICY ON ADMISSION

St. Joseph’s College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu established by Fathers of the Society of Jesus, as a religious minority College, adheres to the reservation policy of the State Government of Tamil Nadu, regarding admission of students to various courses offered in the College.

In Shift I (Aided Programme): 50 per cent of seats are filled as per the directives of the State Government of Tamil Nadu’s reservation policy of admitting different groups/categories of students and the remaining 50 per cent of seats are filled from the minority students. The following are the split-up percentages (out of 50%) allotted for different groups/catagories, fulfilling the requirements of the State Government’s reservation policy.

Groups	OC	SC	ST	BC	MBC
Percentage	15.5	9	0.5	15	10

The selection of students for General (Open Competition) category, comprising of the above categories/groups (SC,ST, BC and MBC) is done on merit. After admission, they will be placed in their respective community. Therefore, the ‘General’ column may be marked as FC (Forward Community).

In Shift II (Unaided Programmes): 30 per cent of seats are filled, as per the reservation policy of the State Government and the remaining 70 per cent of seats are filled from the minority students.
