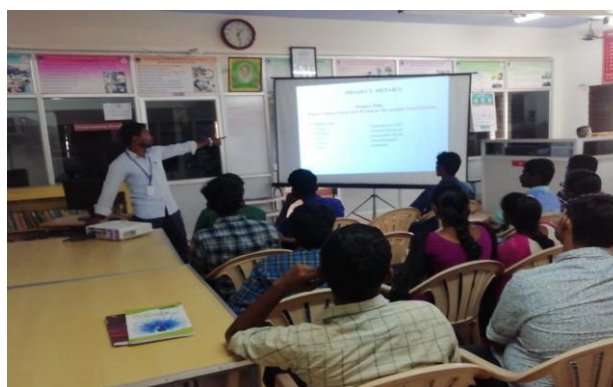

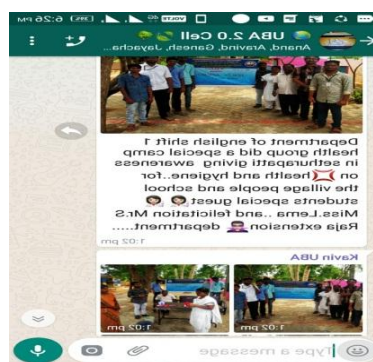

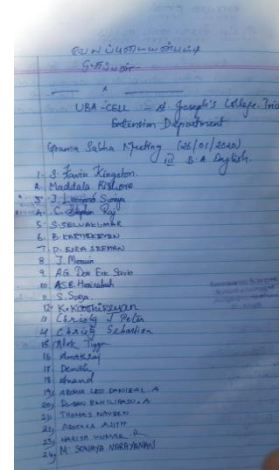

## **8. 2. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 – Need of Water Management a brief note:**

Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0, the institutions are selected on a Challenge Mode and the scheme has been extended to 750 reputed Higher Educational Institutes (both public and private) of the country. Also, the scope for providing Subject Expert Groups and Regional Coordinating Institutes to handhold and guide the participating institutions have been strengthened.

IIT Delhi has been designated to function as the National Coordinating Institute for this program and the Ministry of Human Resource Development intends to extend the coverage to all the reputed Higher Educational Institutes, in a phased manner. Each selected institute would adopt a cluster of villages / panchayats and gradually expand the outreach over a period of time. Institutes through their faculty and students, will carry out studies of living conditions in the adopted villages, assess the local problems and needs, work out the possibilities of leveraging the technological interventions and the need to improve the processes in the implementation of various government schemes, prepare workable action plans for the selected villages. Such knowledge inputs would make their way into the development programs in rural areas.

The Institutes would be expected to closely coordinate with the district administration, elected public representatives of Panchayats / villages and other stakeholders and will become very much a part of the process of development planning and implementation.

In this process, faculty and students of such institutes would be re-oriented and connected to the rural realities so that their learning and research work also becomes more relevant to society.

### **Rural Sanitation**

If water is life, sanitation is surely a 'way of life' and access to such facilities has an impact on the quality of human life and health. A holistic definition of sanitation includes **safe drinking water**; liquid and solid waste management, environmental cleanliness and personal hygiene. Failing to ensure any one of these can have direct implications on the individual/family/community's health. Environmental cleanliness and sanitation were subjects closest to Mahatma Gandhi's heart who proclaimed that "cleanliness is next to godliness".

### **Objectives of the Project:**

- To conduct street play on water conservation and Recharge the ground water
- To give Special lecture and Project Explanation to Village people
- To Clean the thorns and Shrubs in rain water path places

- To Make proper path for rain water
- To Channelize rain water for recharge the ground water
- To arrange stone in rain water path scientifically.
- To build the Recharge Pit
- To fill the martial according to the recharge ground water system
- To make small holes in bore pipe for recharge water
- To monitoring and follow up the project

## **9. Phase I – Pilot Study & Water Management Awareness Program:**

### **Pilot Study:**

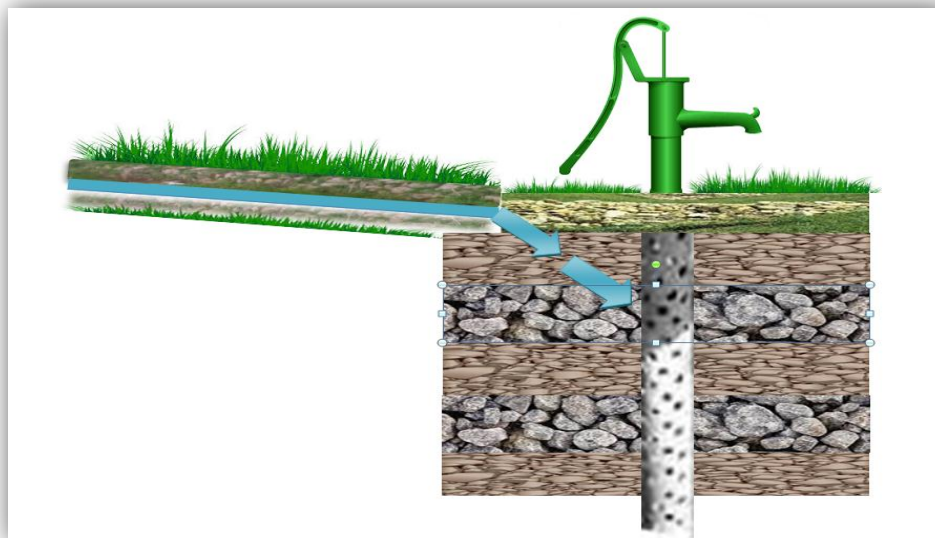
During our pilot study, the students were engaged to observe need of the village housing area where rain water to the ground was improperly channelized. The rain water paths and bore wells were abandoned with thorny bushes and shrubs. For, the ground water level was so poor that the plan of implementing recharging the rain water system after having discussion with the leaders and villagers. The study took a long while in order to progress it scientifically for the sustainable benefits of the villagers.

### **Awareness Program on Water Management:**

The program was planned to facilitate the villagers at first in order to equip them with basic simplified ideas on water management. Initially, the street play on environmental degradation was conducted at the village in order to mobilize the villagers for the program. Rev. Fr. M. Berchmans SJ, Director, Extension Department – SHEPHERD, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous) delivered the inaugural address. Mrs. A. Emelda Lily Gracy, President, Alathur Panchayat, Manikandam Block, Trichy felicitated the gathering for the effectiveness of the program that was sanctioned to their village. Dr. J. Uma Maheswari presided over the program as chief guest. Dr. M. Basker gave a special key note address on methods and strategies of water conservation at the program. Also, the students presented different cultural themes on water management as dance and skit. Mr. J. Jeffrin, II BSc Maths 'A' delivered a welcome note. Mr. S. Raja, Seior Coordinator thanked the gathering concluding with a sign of successful program.



### 9.1. Phase II Model 1 - Methodology (Percolation Pit Method):



S. No	Stages of Work	Work Order - Man Power & Machinery
1	Stage - I	Cleaning the project area
2	Stage - II	Deepening the ground 3.1 meter in & around the bore well
3	Stage - III	Make hole in pipe and cloth
4	Stage - IV	Tie up mess
5	Stage - V	Fill up with big stones
6	Stage - VI	Fill up with big jalli
7	Stage - VII	Small jalli
8	Stage - VIII	Mess layer
9	Stage - IX	Sand
10	Stage - X	Build pit with cement & Stone blocks

The three project area was cleaned by the local labors after the requisition from the panchayat president of the village. The percolation pit was deepened with the measurement of three point one meter (3.1m) depth around the bore well. The deep installed bore well pipe was surrounded with iron mess, one and half inches black jalli, filled with sand and finishing up the area building bricks with cement patch work. The project area was successful because those were the places where rain water stream usually flows. It is obvious construction of percolation pit would enable recharging the ground water constructively.

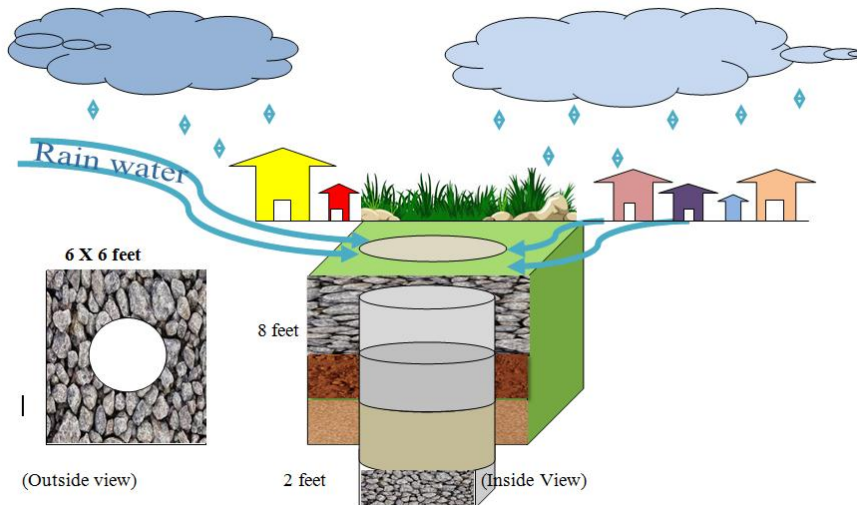








## 9.2. Model 2 – Methodology (Water Recharge Well Method):



S. No	Stages of Work	Work Order – Man Power & Machinery
1	Stage – I	Cleaning the project area
2	Stage – II	Pit preparation
3	Stage – III	Cement ring
4	Stage – IV	Full the big jalli outer side
5	Stage – V	Small jalli outer side
6	Stage – VI	Gravel filling
7	Stage – VII	Sand filling
8	Stage – VIII	Cover by Cement ring

The project area was cleaned and the preparation work was done with possible local man power. The area was chosen in the road side of rain water canal of the village. The cement ring and jalli stones were erected in the project area with the depth of five feet (5ft). The pit also filled up with gravel stones and sand for the better result. At last, the cement rings were packed up with cement paste for the best result in recharging the streamed rain water in the canal. The success of the project is engaged with the manual work by the local human resources. The material was purchased in the locality.
